

Instructor Training System

To assist in developing a guality instructor training system, five stages were identified as essential for States and/or programs to successfully train driver education instructors.

Stage	Pre-Screening and Entry Assessments
Stage	Foundations of Novice Driver Education (The Driving Task)
Stage	The Teaching Task/Teaching and Learning Theories

Each Stage is a critical component and each may require course development by the State or program. The model training curriculum that has been developed assists in teaching Stage III The Teaching Task.

Master instructors teaching this course should receive a training course on how to utilize these materials.
