The Curriculum includes three parts:

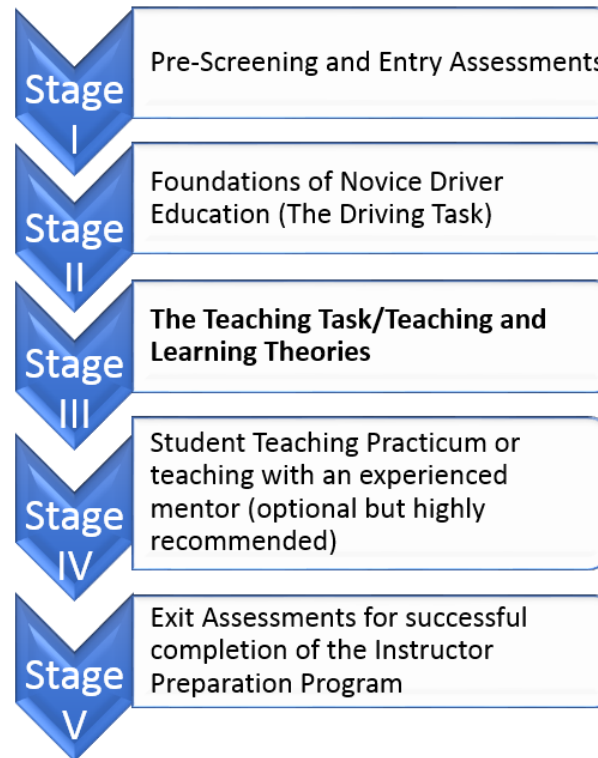
- The Fundamental Concepts of Teaching and Learning,
