TITLE

Develop and Implement Professional Teaching Standards for NTDETAS Project Management Plan

PURPOSE

This document serves as the project management plan for the Association of National Stakeholders in Traffic Safety Education (ANSTSE) project to develop and implement professional teaching standards for NTDETAS, allowing states to monitor and promote the driver education profession.

BACKGROUND

The NTDETAS were initially released in 2009 and updated in 2017 by ANSTSE to assist in improving the administration of driver education programs nationally. ANSTSE, an association of major stakeholders, was created to maintain and, when necessary, upgrade the Standards and to provide oversight in implementation activities. This volunteer group of ANSTSE stakeholders consists of:

Brett Robinson of Highway Safety Services serves as the Secretariat.

In 2017, ANSTSE, with assistance from a working group, developed a Model Training Curriculum for the Teaching Task Instructor Preparation Program. ANSTSE also developed Stages for a Driver Education Instructor Preparation Program. One of the stages involves a student teaching practicum or teaching with an experienced mentor. Guidelines need to be developed on mentoring. More information also needs to be provided on master trainers and train-the-trainer programs.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this project are to:

1. Develop and implement professional teaching standards for NTDETAS, allowing States to monitor and promote the driver education profession.

SPECIFIC ACTIVITIES

1. Prepare a Project Management Plan (PMP)

Create a 2-year PMP for revising the existing driver education instructor qualification standards, developing standards for trainers-of-trainers and mentors to support the NTDETAS. The COR will review and provide comments.

2. Form a Core Working Group

Form a small core working group of SMEs to assist with developing the driver education instructor standards (this working group will also serve as the working group to provide recommendations to update the NTDETAS Section 3 Instructor Qualifications).

3. Develop the Professional Teaching Standards

Three specific areas in support of driver education professional standards will be to:

- Revisit the existing instructor qualifications standards in Section 3 of the NTDETAS to identify potential updates.
- Develop standards for trainers-of-trainers to be incorporated into the NTDETAS Section 3 Instructor Qualifications.
- Develop standards for mentors to be incorporated into the NTDETAS Section 3 Instructor Qualifications to assist with teaching practicums for mentorship programs.

4. Prepare and Submit Revised PMP

Revise the 2-year PMP that outlines the plan to develop professional teaching standards and have the COR review and provide comments.

DELIVERABLES

Phase I

- 1. Submit a 2-year Project Management Plan to develop professional teaching curricula standards and an implementation strategy for NTDETAS.
- 2. Submit revised 2-year Project Management Plan to develop and incorporate Professional Teaching Standards into NTDETAS.

Phase II

3. Submit final developed professional teaching curricula standards and implementation strategy for NTDETAS.
