

May 2023 Novice Teen Driver Education and Training Administrative Standards (NTDETAS) Released!

This document provides guidance for all novice teen driver education and training programs across the U.S. The <u>NTDETAS</u>, supported by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) are recommended and intended to be accepted as the standard for novice teen driver education and training programs, and States are encouraged to adopt and implement them as established.

The Association of National Stakeholders in Traffic Safety Education (ANSTSE), Highway Safety Services, and working groups of subject matter experts assisted with updating the NTDETAS. This current 2023 edition incorporates enhancements including standards on risk/emergency preparedness; data collection; services for drivers with disabilities; virtual classroom training; prerequisites, training, and requirements for candidate instructor trainers and mentors; testing for licensure through driver education; and parent/guardian involvement.
